How to use this template

- 1. Print the template out on card or glue paper to card after printing
- 2. Colour it in
- 3. Cut it out
- 4. Stick on hair and a beard (if you want to!)
- 5. Put your fingers through the holes to make pirate legs
- 6. Practice your pirate lingo! 'Shiver me timbers!' 'Yo ho ho!' 'Ahoy me hearties!'

This finger puppet can be used to join in with 'Pirate Jim's Magic Map' story told by Amanda and available on YouTube at Merry-go-Round Storytelling.

It is also perfect for fun Pirate Role Play activities at home or in school.


